I am partly responsible for the death of officer Hurley and maiming of officer Foley. I am directing this letter to you because you personally know Mrs. Hurley and officer Foley. Recently I have been offered a large sum of money to do a book deal. I would like to offer those rights to Black JT and me or anyone from using my name to make money on the pain which I had to inflict. There's more but I don't want Mrs. Hurley to suffer any longer. Sir, I need your suggestion on what I should do. Al Trenkler is innocent. My father Thomas L. Shay and his attorney Alan Pransky are my real codefendants. We were the ones involved. The bomb was only meant to do property damage not injury to persons. It's a big puzzle but one I can put together which would make sense. I am willing to help you build a case or keep quiet. I will do either for Mrs. Hurley.

The decision is yours. In October of next year I will be released after 10 1/2 years of prison. I would like to request two things. No revenge from Boston Police to me physically. To be able to apologize privately to officer Foley and to Mrs. Hurley. To go on and live a quiet life. I make this offer to you, what you do with it is up to you. Please respond when you can.

Please do contact with Mrs. Hurley as she doesn't want anyone to make money off her husband's death.
