Front of belt splattered and front of clasp completely shattered and broken. and also splattered with various debris and metal appearing fragments. Belt contained One nylon Holster containing 9MM Glock Semi-Automatic Pistol SN # PN 402 US. One Double Magazine Holder leather containing Two Magazines, also two Nylon penlight holders, one containing a pocket knife, and the other a small flash light. On the Magazine holder were noted several reddish brown stains both inside & outside. On the belt was also noted one Key ring containing one set of personal keys approximately 15 keys in all. Belonging to Boston Plice Officer Jeremiah Hurley.

The above items were received from Officer Daniel R. Omogrosso, who received them from Sgt. Thomas Craven, who received them from H.&H. Amb 13 A2 EMT'S Boddie & Reardon, who took them from the victims. The above items were then given to Sgt. Det. William Mahoney of the Homicide Unit.

Sir:

On Monday, October 28, 1991, the above officers along with Officers Robert Doherty and Michael Ahearn of the Bomb Squad went to the Brigham and Woman's Hospital. Upon arrival the above officers went to the Emergency Room and observed Officer Frank Foley in Room 1, being attended by medical personnel of the Brigham and Woman's Hospital. Sergeant Callahan went to the Emergency Room 2 and was advised that Officer Jerry Hurley had been brought to the Operating Room from Room 2. Sergeant Callahan requested permission to retrieve clothing and evidence from June White and Jeanne Flatley of the Brigham and Woman's Hospital who gave permission.

The following items were taken from Room 2, Emergency Room where Officer Jerry Hurley was treated:

1. One battery taken from red bag
2. One black sock taken from red bag

Jeanne Flatley of the Brigham and Woman's Hospital went to the Operating Room and gave Officer Michael Ahearn and Detective James Wyse the following items; taken from Officer Jerry Hurley:

1. 1 white sheet
2. 2 blue blankets
3. 1 piece of black pants
4. 1 piece of black shirt
5. 1 piece of undershorts
6. debris from clothing
7. debris from Operating Room

Sergeant Callahan went to Catscan 7, of the Brigham and Woman's and received permission from Stuart Hooter, telephone number 782-7214 to retrieve items from the room. The following items were taken from Catscan 7: (Officer Hurley's room).

1. 1 black sock taken from basket
2. 1 piece of black shirt with several holes

Taken from Linen basket were the following items from Catscan 7 (Officer Hurley).
