SIR:

I respectfully submit that on October 28, 1991 while performing a paid detail at 1623 Centre St. I responded to a radio call for immediate assistance of injured officers on Eastbourne St. in Roslindale.

On arrival, I observed Sgt. Creavin and P.O. Kraft giving first aid to two severely injured officers in the driveway of 39 Eastbourne St., Roslindale.

I proceeded back out to the street to direct responding medical assistance units.

While standing in front of the house at the driveway opening I was approached by a hysterical white female who had ran up Eastbourne St. from Beech St. The female attempted to enter the property. The female was approximately 5' 7" tall, 150 lbs, W/F, mid 20's, blonde hair, wearing glasses and a purple colored outfit. She repeatedly yelled out "What's going on?" and then "Is he hurt, did he get him?" I restrained the female from entering the crime scene, and led her over toward the front door of the house, where I asked her to sit down and calm down.

I asked her who she was but she only identified herself as living at 39 Eastbourne St. She proceeded to walk up the stairway and was admitted into the house by an unknown person.

I had no further contact with this female nor did I learn her identity.

I then proceeded to tape off the crime scene area, and assist in the removal of the injured officers.
