I respectfully submit to you the following report relative to the incident at 39 Eastbourne St., Roslindale. As you directed, the above named Detectives did go door to door on Havana St. in order to interview residents and develop possible witnesses and to locate further evidence.


This report is laid out numerically by the houses street addresses with the person(s) interviewed found at that location.

- #12 Havana: Dottie Murphy states that she observed a unknown white motor vehicle being towed from the street on 10/27/91 @ 8:30 p.m.
- #16 Havana: Patricia and Kathleen Needham states they were inside the home when the explosion was heard, they went outside and observed the smoke rising over the garage. they further stated that the smoke had a pungent odor to it. At this location we also spoke to Nick Debenedictis of 31 Eastbourne St. who stated he had already spoken with Sgt. Det. Childers at the scene.
- #22 Havana: Melinda Beggan states that she observed a car being towed from the street on 10/27/91 @ 9:30 p.m. She further states that she heard the explosion but observed nothing.
- #24 Havana: Lorraine O'Connell lives directly behind location of incident and states that she has not observed anything out the ordinary in the past few weeks and was in front of her home at the time of the incident.
- #28 Havana: No answer, Listed in Cole's as Fredrick F. Schmitt (323-2737).
- #36 Havana: No answer, Listed in Cole's as Edward F. Coppinger (327-1191).

In addition to the above addresses, Detectives Kelly and Mosher did interview the residents of 217 Beech St., the home of Donald, Mary and David Heim who stated that they have not observed anything out of order as of late and are in fact, friends of the Shay family.
