Sir:

I respectfully submit that on the above date while working in the E432A I was assigned to transport Mr. Thomas Shay the younger from Area E-5 to the Homicide Unit at approximately 1:55AM.

Before entering my vehicle, Mr. Shay stated to me "I'M sorry about the officer who died, and I don't know what else to say." While in my vehicle I observed Mr. Shay to be acting in a confused state of mind and making such statements as "I wish I could reverse time and make all of this not to have happened." Mr. Shay also stated that he had hitchhiked his way home from Quincy and that he didn't know anything about the explosion until he returned home tonight.
