On Tuesday October 29, 1991 this sergeant had a telephone conversation with attorney Thomas J Freedman, 18 Tremont St Boston telephone number 523-5352 regarding the DEDHAM SERVICE CENTER, 106 Washington St Dedham, owned and operated by Louis Giamarco and Jefferey Beerey. Attorney Freedman stated that he does represent this company in a civil action filed by THOMAS SHAY, and he stated that the chief insurance counsel is GALLAGHER AND GALLAGHER, located at ONE Constitution Wharf in Charlestown, telephone # 2418800. He tells me that in addition to the service station building, there is also a house located next to the service center owned by a person whose name I do not know but it is part of the civil action. Attorney Freedman also tells me that while doing a background check on the position of Thomas Shay, he found that Mr Shay was released from the National Guard for failing to keep proper attendance, he has a copy of the discharge, and that in 1982 he was represented by attorney David Eisenstadt, and after an auto accident, he filed and received the maximum damages of \$100,000.00 settlement. Also in 1986 October auto accident he was examined by a Dr Mahoney who found no causation of injury and it was settled for \$22,000.00 by attys Carter and Carter of Dedham Mass. The latest claim against his clients developed from an incident in 1987 where a explosion in a fifty gallon drum, which was located about 70 feet from the area where Tom Shay is located, and allegedly inner ear damage, after the rent was raised two years later. Mr Shay had a pretty good business going, he filed taxes and for the last five years he projected an increase in income. In 1989 filed a return grossing 49,000. In 1990 he filed with Social Security for a disability claim as a result of the explosion he stated he could not work, but he maintained a body shop in Centre and Spring Sts West Roxbury. Atty Freedman stated he deposed a psychologist who was treated Shay at West Rox Park center, but who now heads the Brigham and Womens Psych ward. Mr Shays other Arthur and Son Thomas were also deposed. Atty Freedman stated he would be willing to cooperate with the police.
