Subject: Bomb Explosion

Sir:

About 11:45 A.M., this date, one Thomas Shay, 47 years old, D.O.B. July 5, 1944 of 39 Eastbourne Street, Roslindale came to Area E-5 and reported to me that he had observed, in his driveway, a metal box, with what appeared to be magnets on it and wires sticking out of it.

I asked Mr. Shay if he had any problems with anyone or had he been threatened. He stated that he did not suspect anyone of planning to hurt him in any way.

Mr. Shay told me that he lived at Eastbourne Street with his girlfriend Flanagan and their six year old child. He did say that he was involved in a civil action.

At this point I contacted the bomb squad and spoke to Police Officer Foley and related the above circumstances. Officer Foley stated that they would respond and requested me to call the dispatcher and ask them to dispatch the Bomb Squad over the air. He also asked me to have the dispatcher send a service unit to stand by to await the Bomb Squad.

I contacted the dispatcher, Police Officer Valerie Johnson who stated she would send the above units.

At this point I asked Mr. Shay to return to his residence and await the arrival of the units.
