REPORT OF INTERVIEW

With Mrs. Josephine Wallace, on November 19, 1991 at 5:30 P.M., at 7 White Lawn Street Milton, Ma. by Special Agent John S. Paolillo and Special Agent Henry J. Moniz Jr., Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms Mrs. Wallace states as follows:

Mrs. Wallace said that she is married and lives at 7 White Lawn Street Milton, Ma. with her husband Jack. She has a son named Alfred Trenkler and a son named David Trenkler. Mrs. Wallace told us that she and her husband are both realtors.

Mrs. Wallace stated that her son Alfred does not lived at home for the past 6-7 months. However, he does still receive his mail there and stops by a few times per week. Alfred stores some of his work tools in the garage but has taken most of them out. Mrs. Wallace does not know what type of tools that Alfred stores, but she said that most of them have been taken out when Alfred move out.

Mrs. Wallace said she knew of the 1986 incident where Alfred was charged for making a bomb in state court. Mrs. Wallace refered to the incident of being very unimportant and she also called the bomb that was made as a "Firecracker". She further stated that everything was blown out of proportion and Alfred has not been in trouble since then.

DETAILS (Continued)

At one time while Alfred was working for the Arch Diocesess he had a slight problem with an individual named Joe Sweeney. Alfred and Sweeney had a falling out over a business transaction but nothing threatening was ever exchanged between the two parties. Other than his problem with Sweeney Mrs. Wallace could not recall any other problems that Alfred has had.

Mrs. Wallace described her son as being very even keel and not one to fly off the handle. She also said that Alfred had financial problems at one tiime but has since then resolved them.
