search of his business. Mr. Trenkler admitted building a remote control bomb in 1986 for John and Donna Shea and placing the bomb on a truck in Quincy, Massachusetts. Mr. Trenkler admitted that he was arrested by Quincy Police and that he confessed to the Quincy Police that he had build the bomb.

Mr. Trenkler said that he had an electronics background and had been employed by several companies in the electronics field. Mr. Trenkler said that ARCOMMM installs microwave dishes and towers and installs cellular phones in cars as well as leasing/renting pagers to the public.
