REPORT OF INTERVIEW

With Stephen Murray, on February 3, 1992 at 2:15 P.M. at 222 Centre St, Quincy, MA by Special Agents Sandra R. Lacourse and Edmond G. Cronin of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms, Boston, MA. Mr. Murray stated the following:

Mr. Murray stated that his date of birth is August 3, 1953 and that he resides at 64 Grove St., Norwell, MA. He stated that his mailing address is P.O. Box 99, Accord, MA 02018. Murray related that he met Thomas Shay Jr. at Store 24, Washington St., Quincy, MA. Murray stated he works at the Store 24, he stated he typically works midnight to eight AM and works the evening shift when Scott Critcher is on a day off. Murray related Shay Jr. came into the Store 24 on Thursday, October 24, 1991 looking for Scott Critcher. Murray remembered that Critcher had completed his shift that night and that he told Shay Jr. that Critcher was gone for the night. Murray stated he next saw Shay Jr. at a Halloween Party at Scott Critcher's house, 222 Centre St., Quincy, MA on Sunday, October 27, 1991 at approximately 12:15 A.M. Murray stated he had worked an evening shift at the Store 24 and then went straight to Critcher's house. The party was winding down as he arrived and there were not that many people at the house. Murray stated Shay Jr. was there. He related that Shay Jr. stated to him he had drank four to five bottles of liquor and a six pack of beer at the party. Murray stated his observation of Shay was that he was sober and that he was lying about his drinking. He related that Shay left the party

Murray stated he learned of the Roslindale bombing from the news media and that he called Scott Critcher to tell him about Shay Jr.'s father being in the news. Murray stated he did not see Shay Jr. again until after January 1, 1992. He stated he saw him at Critcher's house in Quincy, he related he asked Shay Jr. how he got out of jail. He stated Shay Jr. told him a guy from Washington state sent him the bail money. Murray did not know the amount that was sent to Shay Jr. Murray related the only other conversation he had with Shay Jr. was to ask him what jail was like. Murray stated Shay Jr.'s response was that he was not impressed with jail. Murray stated he took this to mean Shay Jr. did not like jail.

Murray was shown a photo spread containing the photograph of Alfred W. Trenkler and five other white males. Murray did not recognize any of the individuals in the photographs.
