9. DETAILS:
REPORT OF INTERVIEW

With Gary Drew Starkey, on April 2, 1992, at approximately 3:00 PM., at Quincy, Massachusetts by Special Agent Jeff S. Kerr, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms. Mr. Starkey stated as follows:

Mr. Starkey stated that his date of birth is 6/6/71 and his social security number is 02 [REDACTED]. He stated that he resides at [REDACTED].

Starkey stated that he first met Thomas Shay in early October, 1991. He stated that they met in Quincy Square, Quincy, Massachusetts. He stated that he and Shay spent that first night together. He stated that the next morning he walked Shay half way home. He stated that prior to departing each other's company, they exchanged telephone numbers and addresses.

Starkey stated that over the course of their short relationship, Shay telephoned him approximately nine times and that he telephoned Shay approximately three times. He stated that Shay lived at the "Falls" condominium complex in Quincy. He stated that Shay thought that they were a couple. He stated that Shay was very possessive and felt that they should be together twenty-four hours a day.

Starkey stated that although he and Shay had spoken on the telephone on a number of occasions, he did not see Shay again until approximately one week later in Quincy. He stated that he (Starkey) was with some friends and that Shay was on the opposite side of the road. He stated that Shay just waved.

DETAILS (Continued)

Starkey stated that on only one occasion did he make plans to spend time with Shay. He stated that this was a few days after he had seen Shay walking on the opposite side of the road in Quincy. He stated that they made plans to have a few beers but that they just ended up hanging out in Quincy Square.

Starkey stated that Shay, during the course of their brief friendship, had said that he (Shay) had appeared on the Oprah Winfrey and Phil Donoghue shows as well as People are Talking, a program on local Boston television. He stated that Shay had also informed him that his (Shay's) former boyfriend had been killed by "gay bashers" in front of a gay nightclub. Starkey believed the club was called 1270.

Starkey stated that Shay did not appear to be a violent individual. He stated that Shay claimed that his (Shay's) parents were wealthy, that his relationship with his mother was good and that he had eleven sisters.

Starkey stated that Shay told him about an individual named Randy "LNU". He stated that Randy allegedly owned a clothing store. Starkey stated that Shay called Randy his "daddy", also calling Randy his best friend. Starkey stated that a "daddy" is an older gay male who takes care of a younger man for either friendship and/or sex. Starkey stated that Shay wanted to introduce him to Randy but that this introduction never occurred.

Starkey stated that on Saturday, October 26, 1992 at approximately 8:00 PM., he arrived at the residence of Scott Critcher, a friend who was hosting a Halloween party in Quincy. Starkey stated that when he arrived, Shay was in the kitchen. He stated that he and Shay said hello and that he then went off to look for Critcher. He stated that Shay later began to follow him around the house and after a while requested that he (Starkey) go upstairs with him to talk. He stated that they went upstairs and that Shay gave him a shirt that he had promised him. He stated that Shay wanted to remain upstairs but that he refused and returned downstairs. He stated that Shay was "pissed off" and that Shay went downstairs and asked Critcher to go upstairs with him. He stated that Critcher soon returned downstairs and told him (Starkey) that Shay was very upset and thought that he (Starkey) hated him.

Starkey stated that after explaining the situation to Critcher, Critcher returned upstairs to Shay and informed Shay that he (Starkey) did not hate Shay but that he did not wish to go out with Shay. He stated that Shay was depressed and remained upstairs for a while. He stated that after a short while Shay returned downstairs.

Starkey stated that around midnight/12:30 AM., 10/27/92, Shay asked him how to get home from Critcher's house. He stated that he gave Shay directions and that Shay just left.

Starkey stated that he did not speak with Shay again. He stated that Shay's mother telephoned him (Starkey) and asked him to write to Shay while he (Shay) was incarcerated in Bridgewater State Hospital. Starkey stated that he did not write any letters to Shay.

Starkey stated that approximately two weeks after he had received the telephone call from Shay's mother, Shay tried to telephone him collect. He stated that he refused the call.

Starkey stated that the last time he saw Shay was late February early March. He stated that he saw Shay at the Quincy Center MBTA Station but that they did not speak to one another.
