9. DETAILS:  REPORT OF INTERVIEW  With Greg Calver, on April 2, 1992 at approximately 4:00 PM., at Washington Street, Quincy, Massachusetts, by Special Agent Jeff S. Kerr, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms. Mr. Calver stated as follows:  Mr. Calver stated that his date of birth is 5/31/63 and his social security number is 2 . He stated that his new residence is 68 Union Street, Quincy, Massachusetts, Tel. No. 617-773-4042.  Calver stated that he is employed by Trifone Store 24, 230 Washington Street, Quincy, Massachusetts, Tel. No. 617-773-3839. He stated that his position is Customer Service Representative. He stated that he has been employed with Trifone Store 24 since May 16, 1991. He stated that he works the midnight to 8:00 AM. shift, usually Friday through Tuesday.  Calver stated that he worked Sunday, October 27, 1991, midnight to 8:00 AM. He stated that Thomas Shay, an individual whom he identified from a photograph array, came into the store at approximately 1:00 AM that morning. He stated that Shay told him that he (Shay) had just come from Scott Critcher's Halloween party. He stated that Shay was strange and that he wished that Shay would leave the store.  Calver stated that Shay stood by the door. He stated that he doesn't recall if Shay purchased anything or if he had any money. He stated that Shay just wanted to hang out and talk about Critcher's party. He stated that Shay acted like he was a long time friend of Critcher's. He stated that Shay departed the store at approximately 3:00 AM., prior to him

(Calver) washing the store floor.

Calver stated that he next saw Shay in November, 1991. He stated that he asked Shay about the bomb that exploded at his (Shay's) father's residence. He stated that Shay said that he (Shay) didn't do it but that the police thought that he did do it because he had once phoned in a bomb threat trying to get back at the M.B.T.A. Calver stated that he did not know why Shay wanted to get back at the M.B.T.A.

Calver stated that Shay told him that the bomb which exploded at his (Shay's) father's residence was actually intended for Shay Jr. himself. He stated that he asked Shay why somebody would want to kill him and that Shay told him that it was just the way some things go and that was just the way some people are.
