On Monday, April 13th,1992 at approximately 3:00pm, Det. Brendan Craven served a subpoena for a federal grand jury convening in Boston on Thursday April 16th,1991 to one Thomas Thomson, w/m, 60 yrs. of 80 Peterborough St.,apt. # 44, Boston, MA 02215.

Mr. Thomson stated that he knew of Alfred Trenkler and Donna Shea since sometime in 1979 and that they would occasionally light off M-80's in the Fenway area. Thomson also known as Tommy Red cap stated that he would get upset when Trenkler would ignite any higher explosives.

Thomson stated that he has spoken to Trenkler within the last two weeks. Thomson stated that he feels that Al Trenkler has no involvement in the death of P.O. Hurley and stated that he did not wish to discuss the matter anymore. He also stated to Craven that he was a member of the gay community.
