DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO SUPPRESS EVIDENCE DERIVED

Now comes the Defendant, Alfred Trenkler, and moves this Court to suppress from use in evidence any and all evidence seized or derived from the search pursuant to warrant of the offices of ARCOMM, Inc., located at 82 Broad Street, Weymouth, MA, an area as to which the Defendant enjoyed a reasonable expectation of privacy.


As grounds therefore, the Defendant says there were deliberate and material misrepresentations of fact in the affidavit upon which the Magistrate-Judge relied in issuing the warrant. The Defendant further says that in the absence of the material misrepresentations, the affidavit is insufficient as a matter of law to establish probable cause for the issuance of the warrant.
