Dear Terry:

Confirming our telephone conversation of this morning, after consultation with other prosecutors in my office, I have decided not to make early release of the Jencks Act statement which I informed you of the existence of late last week. For witness security and other reasons, I now intend to wait until shortly before trial to disclose this statement to you.

For your benefit, however, I will confirm what I told you last week -- that I have a credible witness who is prepared to testify to various admissions by your client, including the fact that Trenkler stated that it was he who built the bomb which exploded in Roslindale on October 28, 1991. The government has made no promises, rewards or inducements to this witness.


