On October 17, 1991 I was working for Arcorn  
and was at the Houston Science Center  
helping set up electronic dishes and a  
helicopter was used on this date. Also working  
when the helicopter was used, <sup>was</sup> Rich Brown  
and Alfred Treubler. The job didn't get  
completed on this date.

On October 18, 1991 I was again working  
for Arcorn. On this date I was working  
at the shop in Weymouth on Broad  
Street next to a fire station. I started  
work around 9 o'clock in the morning.  
I was painting the interior part of the  
building. I was painting walls and pipes  
and ceiling. I remember this because of  
the colors red, white and blue being used.  
On October 18, 1991 the following people were  
at the Arcorn building painting. Richard

Brown, me, Al Treubler, Bob J. Stocco  
maybe David Flaherty

On this particular day, I believe that  
Al Treubler sent me out to pick up  
the lunch from Kentucky Fried Chicken.  
We ate dinner at the Accorun office  
and continued working until 5 P.M.  
I believed that Al Treubler left the office  
when we all stopped working around  
5 o'clock. I never saw Al Treubler leave  
the office this day until we all left the  
building at the end of the day.

On the following the 19<sup>th</sup> of October 1991 I  
again worked for Accorun. Rick Brown  
myself and Dave Flaherty worked at this  
site taking the scaffolding down from the  
Astron Science Center. We all went to rent  
the van and there were strikers picketing  
the place. After we took the scaffolding  
down and returned it to Man Scaffolding  
and believe it was the same day we took  
the scaffolding down.

I have been given an opportunity to  
read and review this statement consisting  
of 3 pages and have been given the  
opportunity to make any corrections or  
change. This statement is true and correct  
in my best recollection.
