DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO COMPEL PRODUCTION
OF CERTAIN DISCOVERY

Now comes defendant and respectfully requests this Court order the government now to provide certain discovery it had previously agreed to supply. More particularly, defendant requests:

1. copies of all auto photos shown to witness Thomas McKernan; and
2. a copy of the report concerning the showing of the photo spread to various witnesses.

In support of this motion defendant states:

1. On January 25, 1993, the government filed a consolidated response to defendant's discovery motions. At page 3 of that response, the government memorandum states:

D. Motion For Disclosure of Means of Identification

The government agrees to comply with this request to the extent provided in Fed. R. Crim. P. 16(a)(1)(c). In this regard, the government agrees to provide copies of all photographic or handwriting displays used during the investigation, the date(s) such displays were employed, the name(s) of the person(s) to whom the displays were shown, the name(s) of the law enforcement officer(s) who showed the display, and all reports of the results of such showings.

Allowed to the extent of the government's agreement.
