
DEFENDANT'S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE
A MEMORANDUM OF LAW IN EXCESS OF TWENTY (20) PAGES
IN OPPOSITION TO GOVERNMENT'S MOTION *IN LIMINE*
TO ADMIT EVIDENCE OF 1986 BOMBING

Now comes defendant, Alfred W. Trenkler, and moves this Court, pursuant to Local Rule 7.1(B)(4), for leave to file a memorandum of law in opposition to the governments's motion *in limine* to admit evidence of 1986 bombing in excess of twenty (20) pages. In support of this motion, defendant states the following:

- 1) The evidence relating to the 1986 incident is a critical evidentiary issue in this case.
- 2) Defendant received a thirty-three (33) page memorandum of law from the government in support of its position to admit evidence of the 1986 incident.
- 3) To fully discuss the numerous issues raised by the government, it was necessary to exceed the twenty (20) pages limitation of Local Rule 7.1.

WHEREFORE, defendant respectfully requests this Court to grant him leave to file a memorandum of law in opposition to the governments's motion *in limine* in excess of twenty (20) pages.


