My family has been devastated by this entire nightmare. My family lives at 7 Whitelawn Avenue, Milton, Ma 02186. The reason I am writing you is that I request to be placed somewhere close to the Boston area pending my appeal, so that I may assist council on my appeal. I am now located in the Hillsboro Cirty Department of Corrections in Manchester, NH.

Anything you could do to help keep me in the Boston area would be truly appreciated by both my family and myself.
