Interview of Jack Sordillo		10-28-91

On Monday, October 28, 1991 Sgts Flynn & Spellman, Dets Dwyer & Molloy went to the Dedham P.D. and had conversation with Dedham detectives Sgt. Mike Ware, Marty Fitzhenry and Dan Panciocco relative to the bombing incident at 39 Eastbourne St.

At that time the above officers went to 106 Washington St., Dedham to the Dedham Service Center, phone # 326-1420. Upon arrival we spoke with Jeffrey Berry and Louis Giamarco relative to the lower level of the garage which was formerly rented by Thomas Shay. They told us that Jack Sordillo now rented the space and directed us downstairs to speak to him.

Jack Sordillo, W/F, dob 5-3-56 of Union St., Revere, phone 289-2916. Sordillo stated that he had been renting the garage space and also did auto body work. He stated that he had never met Shay and knew nothing about his business other than an occasional former customer of Shay who would come by the shop looking for him. He also stated he knew nothing about the bombing incident.
