D. Echo Dispatcher.

E-5. Yeah, all right. Is this Echo Dispatcher.

D. Yes, it is.

E-5. Yeah, this is Bob Maloney, Detective in E-5.

D. Em hem.

E-5. I just had a fellow come to the desk to the office
and he says there's unusual box in his driveway
with wires sticking out and magnets on it and he's
had some trouble. I called the Bomb Squad,
Officer Foley. He said they'll go out there if
you will dispatch them.

D. Okay. That's area A, yeah. What I'm saying is
the Bomb Squad is on Alpha, so just give me the
information and I'll tell them to send over
again.

E-5. 39 Eastbourne, E-A-S-T-B-O-U-R-N-E.

D. Okay.

E-5. Street.

D. Okay.

E-5. The name is Shay. Would you mind sending a marked
unit up to stand by until they get there.

D. Sure.

E-5. Good. Thank you very much.

D. Okay.

At the tone New England Telephone time will be
11:54 and 10 seconds, temperature 56 Fahrenheit.
At the tone New England Telephone time will be.

Officer Gallette.

Echo/Fox 1.

D. Officer Gallette, you're breaking off.

Yes, sir, go ahead. Fox/Echo 1.

D. Yeah, would you swing over to Channel 4, Area #. They got a threat at 39 Eastbourne, in West Roxbury I believe. She'll tell you.

Okay, I'll switch over.

D. Echo 4-3-3. I'm going to take you off at 19.

....3

D. Yes, maam, I'll have to take you off at 19. Come over to 39 Eastbourne Street. It's going to be possibly be a bomb. The Bomb Squad's also going to come over.

39 Eastbourne, I have it.

Fox/Echo 1.

D. Fox/Echo 1, would you come over to that 39 Eastbourne Street. Could be a possible bomb, there's a box in the driveway.

We have it, we're on our way maam.

Echo 1.

Echo Base. Could we have the Echo 3-72 into the house.

12:00 o'clock exactly, temperature 57 Fahrenheit. At the tone New England Telephone time will be 12:00 o'clock and 10 seconds.

33. I'm Adam/Robert. What number was that again?

D. Number 39, maam, 3-9.

Fox/Echo 1. Adam/Robert.

D. Acknowledge sir.

12:15 and 30 seconds, temperature 56 Fahrenheit.

At the tone New England Telephone time will be 12:15 and 40 seconds, temperature 56 Fahrenheit.

Echo 4-33.

Echo 9-11. Get us an ambulance out at Eastbourne in a hurry.

D. Eastbourne, all right.

11.

D. 9-11, did you say you need H and H down at Eastbourne.

Hurry. Injured officer, injured officer. Get an ambulance in a hurry.

D. All right sir.

.....do you need help? Where are you sir?

He's on Eastbourne.

Get the ambulance in a hurry, make it a double. Two injured officers. Make it two, make it two ambulances.

D. All right sir.

Echo Base. Have the 1-0-1 contact by landline.

Contact by landline.

Get them on the way quick.

D. I have them on the way sir. I've given it to them, They're on their way.

Double (cuts off).

Okay, sir, Eastbourne.

Off of Bourne Street, in Jamaica Plain, Forest Hills.

It's up off of Beech Street. Come off of Beech Street

41's responding.

Come up to 33 Beech Street in a hurry.

What have you got there?

Injured officer. Get some help right away. An ambulance is what I need.

Get some cars to clear that Washington Street up there.

D. 9-11, sir, could you give me an update on the injuries. What we will need up there?

Explosion, a bomb exploded. There's two injured officers. Hurry up.

32. I'm going to up to Roslindale Square to open it up.

.....double.

4-4. We're going to head down that way.

D. Sir, it would help if you could tell me what the injuries are so we can get you the correct.....

A bomb exploded in the officer's face. Just get the ambulance in a hurry.

Echo 1-0-3 is going.

The medics. Get the paramedics in a hurry too.

D. All right, sir, I have them on the way. I have two on the way.

Thanks. The officer in charge of the ambulance is here too.

.....

D. Sir, you've got four ambulances on the way. The paramedics and Fire is also responding.

.....can you give us the route that they're going so we can try and open it for them.

No, no police cars come up the streets. Let no police cars come up the streets. Just the ambulances. This is a bad street.

What number are you Sarge? What number?

D. Number 39, sir.

39, 39. No police cars up here. All I want is the ambulances.

39 Beech.

2-33 Beech.

D. All right. Sarge, they should be there within three minutes sir. H and H within three minutes.

Push it.

Echo 9-8-1.

D. 9-81.

The 8-21. We're going to go up there.

D. All right.

Is that Eastbourne right off of Beech?

Beech, it's run off 2-35 Beech, Eastbourne.

Is that the one up past Roslindale Square?

Exactly. Come down from the Pleasant Cafe, that's Beech, number 2-32. It's down between Beech and the parkway.

The ambulance just passed the station. The ambulance just went by the station.

9-81. Adam/Robert.

D. All right.

1. Adam/Robert on the scene.

D. I have it.

Echo Detail.

D. Echo Detail.

That's for the West Roxbury Parkway all the way up. Shut down Beech all the way.

D. Okay. Are you saying shut down Beech Street?

Yeah. No regular traffic on Beech in either direction.

D. Have I got a unit to go up there now and shut that down?

We have four units up here now Val.

D. All right.

..... We need a bike up here to do an escort.

Any unit headed up here at Beech Street open the road. Any unit on Beech Street open the road. We got to get an ambulance here in a hurry.

D. All right. Open up the road on Beech Street. Open the road, but hold off the traffic.

What hospital are they going to?

D.

They're going to Brighams and City.

We don't know yet. We're trying to take care of them right here right now.

.....

Echo/Bravo 2. Have all the officers at the site of the injured officers begin to clear this area. We might still have an active bomb here. I want all the officers to clear this area of all unnecessary personnel.

D. All officers now clear that area. All officers now unnecessary clear the area now.

.....

Echo/Bravo 1.

D. Bravo 1.

Yeah, are there any additional bomb personnel?

D. Do you have it. I have to go over to Alpha, sir. Do you want me to send someone over?

Yeah, right away I need any bomb people that you've got. I got to have them up there with supervisors.

D. All right sir.

Any bomb unit supervisors go out right away over to Area E, any bomb unit supervisors go right over to Channel E right away.

Echo 4-23. I'm up here too.

D. All right. I'm now getting that we have an active bomb now under one of the officers. Please clear the area. Any unnecessary personnel now clear the area. We have an active bomb under one of the officers. All officers clear the area.

Echo/Bravo 1.

D. Echo/Bravo 1.

Yeah, would you contact District 14 and see if

Lieutenant Bob Molloy is at work, he's a former bomb person.

D. That's Officer Bob Molloy?

Right.

Yeah, that's Lieutenant Robert Molloy, formerly of the Bomb Unit, now works at District 14. Would you also check the personnel officer up there and see if you can contact him at home if he's not at work.

D. All right. I'll do that sir. I'm also trying to get an additional Bomb Squad from Alpha.

Echo 1-0-1. Me and my partner will be on Beech and Eastbourne.....

.....

D. There's too many units on. That 1-1 come back on.

Echo 1. We'll on be Beech and Eastbourne to get these ambulances in and out.

D. You tried to get Beech.

Echo/Bravo 1. Will you go to Channel 1 please.

D. Bravo 1, who are you looking for on 1?

The 1-0-1. Okay. We're trying to get the ambulance out of here....., in and out. We just wanted to let you know in case somebody....
..... at the other end.

Echo/Bravo 1. Will you go to Channel 1 please.

.....

D. Echo/Bravo 1. Sir, are you looking for the Echo/Bravo 1 or do you want someone Echo/Bravo 1.

No, this is the Echo/Bravo 1. Would you go to Channel 1 please.

D. Operations on 1. Sir, we're trying to contact..... We're trying to contact now for additional Bomb Squad, but I will contact State Police. Let you know sir.

Echo 3-72.

D. Echo 3-7-2.

Can we have another Bomb Squad.....up here.

D. I'm trying sir. We're trying to get someone now.

Bomb supervisor up here.

D. That unit on.

Bravo 2.

Echo/Bravo 2. Any officer on this scene try to locate whoever has the key to the rear ambulance. That ambulance has to be moved as soon as possible.

D. Whoever has a key to that ambulance move it as soon as possible. Echo/Bravo 2, you also have the Bomb Squad on the way and we're calling the Lieutenant at his home.

Echo 8-41.

D. 8-41.

Yes, maam, do we have ID and Crime Lab coming down?

D. We've notified all personnel sir. They are on their way.

Okay. Thank you Dispatcher.

Echo 1-4. We're 14-Paul on the..... Do you have us clear?

D. Yes, I do, 1-4.

Victor 9-4-7 to Operations.

D. Victor 9-4-7.

Yeah, in relation to this incident out here can you get me the address of the Colpitts Travel Agency, in Dedham, please.

D. Colpitts Travel Agency.

Correct, we got to pick up a spouse there.

D. All right, sir, will do.

Yeah, that's right before Zayre's on the right hand side of Dedham.

Okay, thank you. On route 1, thank you.

D. All right. Do you still want me to get it, sir, or are you all set?

No,..... If that's where it is I'll pick up the person there. Thank you.

D. 1-4. 1-4.

Go ahead, maam.

D. 4, would you come over to 6-0-8 River Street. (cuts off).in progress, two white males are taking the tires.

6-0-8 River. Heading that way maam.

Echo 3-72.

D. 3-72.

Echo/Bravo 2.

D. Echo/Bravo 2.

Have any car immediately meet me at Beech Street and Eastbourne Street. We're going to have clear this street for the ambulance. I need this unit right away. Any of the units at the scene within hearing distance I need them at this location now.

D. Have a unit down there now. Have a unit down there immediately. Could I have a unit now meet that Echo/Bravo 2 East Street, Eastbourne.

Yeah, 1-0-3's right here.

D. All right.

Have them meet me right at this location, Beech and Eastbourne.

D. Beech and Eastbourne. Meet the Echo/Bravo 2, East, Beech and Eastbourne.

Echo 3-72. Both of the ambulances are going to go straight down the Jamaica Way to the Brigham and Women's Hospital. So if we could get somebody to open that up for us.

Echo 1-4. Adam/Robert.

- Echo 4-41. A CC.
- D. 4-4-1, that's 1-1-9-1-9-3-2-1.
- I thank you.
- Echo/Bravo 2.
- D. Echo/Bravo 2.
- Like to have Homicide Squad up here as soon as possible also.
- D. Sir, I have notified. Everyone is on the way sir.
72. We're on our way to the Brigham Hospital.
- D. To Brigham's. All right, I'll call ahead.
- At the tone New England Telephone time will be 12:38 and 30 seconds, temperature 57 Fahrenheit.
- Echo 1-4. Have you got a callback on that maam?
- D. It's from a pay phone. It just says two white males taking the tires off an older model. No further description.
- Okay, maam. We're here at 6-0-8 now. There's nothing down here. We'll give you an 8-Boy and we'll look around.
- D. Have it.
- Echo 6-6-4. Two cycles are taking this ambulance in.
- Echo 9-81.
- D. 9-81.
- Notify the Crime Lab too we need them down here.
- D. I did sir. They're on their way.
- Thank you muchly.
- Yankee/Charlie 7.
- D. Yankee/Charlie 7.
- Get the Brigham and Women's Hospital.
- D. Okay, I have that sir.
- Echo Base. Will you inform the Captain that

Lieutenant Molloy is on the way. He should be there within five minutes.

D. All right. Echo/Bravo.

Okay. We have that. Thank you.

D. Echo/Bravo 2.

I would also like one piece of fire apparatus here to remain at the scene just in the event.

D. All right. I'll notify fire. Sir, would you like it at 39 Eastbourne or Beech and Eastbourne?

Thank you dispatcher. You're doing a good job there.

D. All right, sir, we got the State Police on the line. Do you still need them to respond?

Yes, I'd like the State Police here as soon as possible.

D. All right, sir, they're still responding.

3-72. We're going to get off the J way here at the Huntington Avenue side and go straight up Huntington to the Brigham's.

D. Any unit down there in that area block off the traffic flow.

.....next right, that's right.

D. That other unit on the air, you're not coming across sir.

.....take those lights.....

D. Can I have the superior down at the scene call Operations 4-6-8-0 as soon as you can. The superior down at the scene contact 4-6-8-0.
