SUBJECT: EXPLOSION, INJURED OFFICERS.

SIR,

ON THIS DATE 10-28-91 ABOUT 11:45A.M. THOMAS SHAY W/M/S 47 YRS D.O.B. 7-5-44 OF 39 EAST BOURNE ST ROSLINDALE CAME INTO AREA E-5 1708 CENTRE ST WEST ROXBURY. THERE HE WAS DIRECTED TO THE SECOND FLOOR AND HAD CONVERSATION WITH DETECTIVE ROBERT MALONEY. THOMAS SHAY STATED TO DETECTIVE MALONEY THAT HE OBSERVED A METAL BOX IN HIS DRIVEWAY WITH MAGNETS ON IT AND WIRES STICKING OUT. DETECTIVE MALONEY CONTACTED OFFICER FOLEY OF THE BOMB SQUAD AND OFFICER FOLEY REQUESTED OF DETECTIVE ROBERT MALONEY TO CALL THE DISPATCHER AND HAVE A SERVICE UNIT STAND BY UNTIL THEY ARRIVE. DETECTIVE ROBERT MALONEY CONTACTED DISPATCHER OFFICER JOHNSON. AT 11:55A.M. THE ECHO-433 P.O. DENISE KRAFT ALONG WITH THE BOMB SQUAD FE01D P.O. FRANK FOLEY AND GERRY HURLEY ALSO THE ECHO 911 SGT THOMAS CREAVEN, RESPONDED TO 39 EAST BOURNE ST ROSLINDALE. UPON ARRIVAL THEY WERE MET BY THOMAS SHAY. THOMAS SHAY DIRECTED THE OFFICERS TO THE RIGHT REAR OF THE BUILDING GOING UP THE DRIVEWAY, THERE HE POINTED OUT THE OBJECT. SUBSEQUENTLY WHILE OFFICERS FOLEY AND HURLEY WERE EXAMINING THE OBJECT IT EXPLODED SERIOUSLY INJURING BOTH FOLEY AND HURLEY. SGT CREAVEN IMMEDIATELY PUT IN A CALL FOR HELP. AMBULANCE A-5 WITH PARAMEDICS P-2 HEALEY, AND ANDERSON TOOK FRANK FOLEY TO THE BRIGHAMS AND WOMENS HOSPITAL WITH MULTIPLE TRAUMA. AMBULANC A-13 BODDIE AND PARAMEDICS P-1 SHEA AND LAWLER TOOK GERRY HURLEY TO THE BRIGHAMS AND WOMENS HOSPITAL WITH MULTIPLE TRAUMA.

THE FOLLOWING COMMANDS AND UNITS REPONDED TO THE SCENE, SUPERINTENDANT JOSEPH SAIA, DEPUTY SUPERINTE NDANT JOSEPH DUNSFORD, DEPUTY SUI ERINTENDANT GERARD McHALE, CAPTAIN PHIL VITTI, CAPTAIN WILLIAM PARLON, LT DETECTIVE McNALLY, SGT DETECTIVE RUSSELL CHILDERS, SGT DETECTIVE JOHN McCARTHY, STANLEY BOGDEN AND DAVE BRODY CRIME LAB, DETECTIVES THOMAS AND FOGARTY, EMERGENCY SERVICE UNIT AND A SLEW OF OFFICERS UNIFORM AND OTHER WISE.

THOMAS SHAY STATES THAT HE LIVES WITH HIS GIRLFRIEND, MARY FLANAGAN W/F/ D.O.B. 1-24-61 OF 39 EAST BOURNE ST ROSLINDALE, MA. TEL 327-7380.

~~THOMAS SHAY FURTHER STATE THAT HE FIRST OBSERVED THE BOMB ON 10-27-91 ABOUT 11:45 P.M. HOWEVER THE FOLLOWING MORNING 10-28-91 HE DROVE HIS BUTCK OUT OF HIS DRIVEWAY AND HEARD SCRAPING AT THAT TIME HE THOUGHT THAT HE WAS BOTTOMING OUT. OBSERVING THE ARTICLE AGAIN (BOMB) HE PICKED IT UP AND EXAMINED IT. FINALLY HE THREW IT AGAINST THE HOUSE. GOING INSIDE HE HAD SECOND THOUGHTS CAME OUT PICKED IT UP AGAIN AND THREW IT UNDER THE FRONT OF THE CAR. AETER SPEAKING WITH A COUPLE OF MECHANICS THAT HE KNEW HE DECIDED TO NOTIFY THE POLICE. SHAY STATED THAT HE DIDN'T HAVE ANY BOYFRIEND OR GIRLFRIEND TROUBLE HOWEVER IN OCTOBER OF 89 HE WAS RENTING A SPACE AT THE DEDHAM SERVICE CENTER 106 WASHINGTON ST DEDHAM FROM LEWIS GIAMARCO AND JEFFREY BEERY BOTH WHITE ABOUT 30 YEARS. JEFFREY BEERY WAS SUPPOSE TO HAVE PLACE A M-80 CHARGE IN AN OIL DRUM EXPLODING IT. THOMAS SHAY STATES HE HAS A LAWSUIT PENDING AGAINST BOTH INDIVIDUALS. ON 11-3-89 ABOUT 3:00P.M. GERRY EISENBERG DUMPED A LOAD OF GARBAGE IN HIS GIRLFRIENDS DRIVEWAY. HOUSING COURT 12-15-89 #80645.~~
