

Sir,

About 11.00 this A.M. Sgt. Det. R. Childers and Det. George Bishop went to 1816 Centre St. West Roxbury, "Sound Security Inc." which is a business that installs automobile alarms, stereos, phones ect.

The Officers talked to a one Roy Kaplan, 34 yrs. S of 6 Govenor Long Rd. Hingham, Mass., the owner, who stated that he remembered a white male, wearing a blue work shirt with the emblem "Shay Auto Body" enter his place of business on Monday, October 28th, about 11.30 A.M. and this man asked him if there was any part to a Z Lock that could fall from under his car. Mr. Kaplan states that he informed this man that there is no part of a Z Lock that could possily fall from a car and he states that the man asked to use the mens room and then left.

Mr. Kaplan states that he felt it was very unusual for a man who is apparantly in the Auto Repair business to ask about a part of a Z Lock falling from a car as the only parts to this lock is a plunger (inside of the vehicle) and a wire with a connection on the end that locks the inside of the hood.
