Randell Stoller		

On Sunday 11/7/91 caused one Randell Stoller, W/M of 18 Lantern Lane, Sharon Ma. to come to the Homicide Unit. Mr. Stoller stated that on Tuesday 10/29/91 he received a telephone call from Tom Shay Jr. requesting a ride to U.Mass, Dartmouth. That he picked up Tom at his home and did drive him to N. Dartmouth. Tom stated that he was leaving his house on his lawyers advice. The media were bothering his family noting that there were only 14 Shays in the book. During the ride Tom stated that his father was the owner of a bar.

Mr. Stoller was asked when he had first met Tommy, he stated that he was in the Bluehills at an overlook, that Tommy was having problems starting his car and asked Mr. Stoller for a battery jump. Mr. Stoller recalls that he and Tommy had a hard time with the positive and negative post on the battery. Further questioning disclosed that Tommy was awkward in handwriting and the use of knives and folks, Mr. Stoller believes that this was due to his ken home and up bringing. There were times when Tommy couldn't speak to Mr. Stoller and wrote notes to Mr. Stoller in his presence

During the time they had known each other Mr. Stoller states that he never met any of Tommy's friends, that on the day he dropped Tommy at Russell's home whom he had never met.

11/3/91

About 10:30 AM this date caused one Randal Stoller a W/M with a dob of 7/21/56 who resides at 48 Lantern Lane, Sharon Mass. to come to the Homicide Unit.

He is the same Randy that took Thomas Shay from Quincy and drove him to U.Mass Dartmouth. Thomas had called Randy at the clothing store. Thomas told him that they tried to bomb his father. That the family lawyers advised the family to leave there home for a while. That his mother was going to stay at her daughters home. The lawyer said that there were only 14 Shays in the phone book.

Randy when asked about any unusual habits of Thomas he stated that there were time when Thomas wrote messages to Randy instead of verbalizing them, when asked why, Thomas stated he couldn't say it.

Randy also made comment on the manner in which Thomas hold's a knife, folk and pen. It is Randy opinion that Thomas was never taught properly.

The first time Randy met Thomas was at an overlook in the Blue Hills. Thomas asked for a battery jump, Randy states that neither one of them could figure out the negative and positive on the battery pole's. Neither of them are mechanically inclined in Randys opinion.
