On November 9, 1991, Special Agents Kerr, D'Ambrosio, Group Supervisor Palaza and ETB Explosives Technician Thomas Wascom, Dets. O'Malley, Thomas and Fogarty interviewed Sgt. Thomas Creaven and Officer Denise Kraft at the Homicide Squad, Boston, P.D.

Sgt. Creaven and Officer Kraft assigned to Area E-5 were the first police officers to respond to the Shea residence on October 28, 1991. Both officers were shown several different size boxes which could have held the plosive device which detonated on October 28, 1991. Each officer was interviewed separately and reconstructed the device to their individual recollection. Subsequent to the interviews, reports of interviews were prepared by the Boston P.D. and will be made part of this case file.
