Cook, on November 8, 1991 at 1430 hours, at 34 Madison Ave., Quincy, MA by Special Agent Thomas D'Ambrosio and Special Agent Dennis Leahy, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms Mr. Cook states as follows:</p> <p>Mr. Cook said that he works for the Boston Fire Department, Maintenance Section, has a date of birth of 8/11/49, SS [redacted] and resides at 34 Madison Ave., Quincy, MA. Mr. Cook said that he did not make a telephone call to Boston Police, Emergency Telephone Number "911" naming Vincent DiSangro as having knowledge of the bombing that occurred on October 28, 1991.</p> <p>Mr. Cook said DiSangro had done 5 years in prison in Florida for accessory to murder. Mr. Cook said that DiSangro was into the numbers (bookmaking) racket.</p> <p>Mr. Cook also said that his Supervisor in the Boston Fire Department was Dennis Flynn, Mayor Ray Flynn's brother.</p>
