DETAILS (Continued)

On January 14, 1992 the Suffolk County D.A.'s office made the decision to seek federal prosecution of the individual or individuals responsible for this crime.

On January 16, 1992 a meeting regarding the Roslindale Bombing Investigation was held at the offices of A.T.F. Present at the meeting were Assistant United States Attorney's Paul Kelley and Frank Libby, ATF Supervisor Victor Palaza and Special Agents Dennis Leahy, Thomas D'Ambrosio and Jeff Kerr. The purpose of the meeting was to formulate an investigative plan for the investigation. Attached is a copy of that plan.

Areas of immediate emphasis are the following:

It is anticipated that the search warrants will be executed and pen registers and trap and traces will be effective by the week of January, 27, 1992.
