ORDER

TO: SPECIAL AGENTS OF THE BUREAU OF ALCOHOL,  
TOBACCO AND FIREARMS AND ITS AUTHORIZED AGENTS

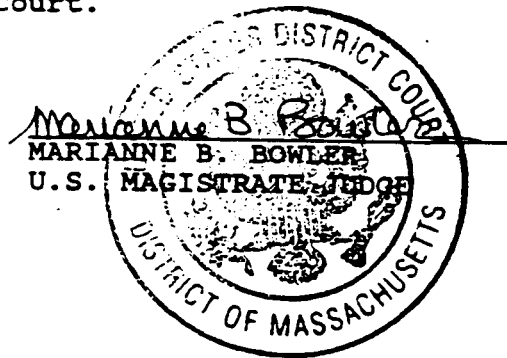
Upon consideration of the Application of the United States of America for an Order authorizing the installation, monitoring, maintaining and removing of an electronic tracking device ("beeper"), and upon consideration of the accompanying incorporated Affidavit of Special Agent Thomas E. D'Ambrosio of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms, I am satisfied that there is probable cause to believe that a 1970 Toyota Celica, color white, Massachusetts Reg. No. 729-BDB, is or may be used by Alfred Trenkler to travel to various locations to meet with unidentified co-conspirators, or to take other actions to conceal his involvement in the commission of offenses in violation of the federal explosives laws, including 18 U.S. C. §§ 371, 844(d) and 844(i).

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that Special Agents of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms, or their authorized agents, are hereby authorized to install, monitor, maintain,

repair, and remove a beeper on or within the above-described vehicle, for a period of not more than thirty (30) days from the date of this Order; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Special Agents of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms, or their authorized agents, are hereby authorized to monitor the beeper at any time of the day or night and wherever the beeper may be located; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the government's Application, supporting Affidavit, and this Order be sealed and impounded until further Order of this Court.
