9. DETAILS:
 REPORT OF INTERVIEW

With David Wallace, on January 31, 1992, telephonically at about 1800 hours, by Special Agent Dennis Leahy, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms, Boston Field Division. Mr. Wallace states as follows:

Mr. Wallace said that that he resides at 16 Nelson Drive, Randolph, Massachusetts, and that his telephone number is 961-2665. Mr. Wallace said that he made the grey wooden box found in the garage at 7 Whitelawn Ave, Milton, Massachusetts. Mr. Wallace said that he was going to use it for target practice as he practices shooting in Maine, and that the black circles on the box were bulleyes for target practice. Mr. Wallace said that he spoke with Al Trenkler before he telephoned ATF. Mr. Wallace described the box as grey primer, made of plywood, (3/8" or 1/2") and that he put it together with sheetrock screws. Mr. Wallace said that the left side of the garage was his and that Al Trenkler used the right side of the garage.
