REPORT OF INTERVIEW

With Evelyn Pirrello and her son, Robert, on February 15, 1992, at 11:00 a.m., at ██████████, by Special Agent Sandra R. LaCourse, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms.

Evelyn and Robert Pirrello stated the following:

Evelyn Pirrello stated that on October 28, 1991, at approximately 11:45 a.m., she had just arrived at her sister's home, Eleanor McKernan residing at 36 Eastbourne St., Roslindale, MA. She stated that upon her arrival, she had pulled her car into the Simm's driveway so that she could back out and parked along the side of Eastbourne St. Simm's driveway is the next driveway up from the McKernan's home. She stated that while she was backing out, Thomas Shay had pulled up behind her preventing her from completing her turn. She stated that he had pulled up to the right side of Eastbourne St. and then backed his car down and parked it just before his driveway's entrance. She stated that there may have been a parked car parked just behind where Shay parked his car. Evelyn stated that she was annoyed by the fact that Shay had pulled his car up behind hers, preventing her from completing her turn around. She stated that she thought about saying something to Shay about it and then decided not to. She stated that she did give Shay a long stare though. She and Robert, both stated that they saw Shay leave the vehicle holding an object in his right hand. When asked to describe the object, Mrs. Pirrello stated that it was about one foot long, either four or five inches wide and flat. She

stated that the object had a drab color. Both Evelyn and Robert stated that he left the car and walked up to the back of his driveway. They both stated that they didn't see him go into the house. Robert stated that he also saw Shay carrying a green toolbox in his left hand. Evelyn wasn't sure if Shay had something else in his other hand or not. Evelyn stated that it appeared to her that Shay was in a hurry. She stated that she thought Shay may have been a service man. She stated that at this time, the police hadn't arrived yet.

She stated that around noon time Jim, Eleanor's husband, had arrived from his walk and that Tommy, Eleanor's son had arrived from Z Lock. She stated that shortly thereafter, they heard the explosion.
