REPORT OF INTERVIEW

With Thomas McKernan, ██████████  
 ██████████ on February 20, 1992,  
 at approximately 4:00 p.m., via telephone,  
 by Special Agent Sandra R. LaCourse,  
 Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms.

Thomas McKernan stated the following:

Thomas McKernan stated that he lives at the above address with his fiancée, Rebecca Wight. Thomas McKernan's telephone number is ██████████ Thomas McKernan stated that on October 28, 1991, at 11:40 a.m., he went to the South Shore Savings Bank in West Roxbury and then to the Z Lock gas station which he stated was located diagonally across from the bank. Mr. McKernan stated that he had kept his bank slip from that date and that it had the time of 11:40 a.m. printed on it. He stated that when he went into the Z Lock, he passed Thomas Shay Sr., who was exiting. Mr. McKernan stated that he waved to Shay Sr. as he was passing him. He stated that in return, Shay Sr. just stared back at him. He stated that he didn't observe Shay carrying anything in his hands. He stated that he knew the individual to be Shay Sr. because he had seen him before, particularly at a wedding which they both had attended a few months earlier. Thomas McKernan stated that after he went to Z Lock, he went to his father and mother's home at 36 Eastbourne Street. Mr. McKernan estimated that he had arrived home around 11:50 a.m. He stated that shortly after his arrival home, his Aunt and Cousin arrived, and then his father came home from his walk which was around noon time. He stated that a few minutes later, they all heard a very loud explosion. Mr. McKernan surmised that Shay Sr. had gone to the police station to report the bomb after he had left Z Lock.
