DETAILS: <p style="text-align: center;"><u>"PROPERTY TRANSMITTAL"</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>REPORT OF INTERVIEW</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;">With Christopher Whitten at 22 Pine Haven Trailer Park Old Town, Maine</p> <p>On March 17, 1992, per request of the Boston Field Division, I interviewed Christopher Whitten at 22 Pine Haven Trailer Park, in Old Town, Maine, in the presence of Sergeant Steve Mason. The interview was recorded.</p> <p>Whitten, 22 years of age lives in a trailer with his parents. He is employed as a security guard in Bangor, Maine. He is in the Army Reserve and occasionally attends Fort Devens in Massachusetts for training. He is a squad leader in a mortar platoon.</p> <p>During the interview, Whitten was very nervous, and at first, would not admit to knowing Thomas Shea, Jr., however, he later stated that in early October 1991 he met Shea at the Grayhound Bus Station in Boston and they talked for two hours. He stated that he had just traveled from Montreal and that he stayed over night in Boston. He stated that the extent of his visit with Shea was at the bus depot only. He stated that this was the only occasion that he met with Shea.</p> <p>Whitten stated that during Christmas Shea wrote him a letter, however, he threw it away. Whitten then provided me with the letter and it was post marked November 16, 1991 from Brockton, Massachusetts. (attached).</p>

Whitten stated that he was not aware of the bombing incident that occurred in Roslindale on 10/29/91.

Whitten was adamant about not taking a polygraph exam, he felt that it would be an invasion of his privacy, however, on this date (3/18/92) he agreed to take an exam. He was informed that it would be arranged at a later date.

Whitten stated that during August and September 1991 he was part of a one hundred man force (Army Reserve Light Infantry) that travelled to New Mexico, and assisted the National Forestry Service with searching for drug fields and drug smuggling.

Whitten allegedly visited a cousin (Aunt's daughter-mother's side) for two weeks just prior to visiting Thomas Shea in Boston.
