9. DETAILS:

This report pertains to ATF's joint investigation with the Boston Police Department into the October 28, 1991 bombing which occurred in Roslindale, Massachusetts taking the life of one Boston Police Department Bomb Technician and critically wounding another.

On June 4, 1992 Thomas A. Shay, a subject of this investigation was subpoenaed into the United States Attorney's Office to provide handwriting exemplars as well as current photographs. As of this date Shay continued to be represented by Attorney William McPhee.

Attorney McPhee, unable to be present for the aforementioned meeting, telephonically instructed Shay to cooperate with A.U.S.A Paul Kelly and ATF Agents Thomas D'Ambrosio and Jeff Kerr. Attorney McPhee informed Shay that if he (Shay) so desired, it would be acceptable to answer any questions asked of him.

Shay was photographed by Special Agent D'Ambrosio and administered a handwriting exemplar booklet by Special Agent Kerr. Additionally, Shay engaged the agents as well as A.U.S.A Kelly in a conversation in which Shay asked as well as answered a number of questions.

Shay stated that he had seen a pink colored list/receipt in Alfred Trenkler's white Toyota, with the same items listed as the items purchased on one (1) Radio Shack receipt dated October 18, 1991, sold to individual named SAHY. This Radio Shack receipt is currently maintained as evidence in the ATF evidence vault.

Shay additionally stated that he and Alfred Trenkler had associated quite

frequently. Shay estimated that the two were together approximately seven (7) times with each time lasting an extended period. He stated that the two had been together often and that on two occasions Trenkler had taken him to his (Trenkler's) work sites.

Shay stated that it was possible that somebody like Al Trenkler may have listened to his (Shay's) complaints about his father. He stated that this person, possibly Al Trenkler may of set about to build a bomb to hurt his (Shay's) father thinking he was doing Shay a favor. Shay stated that this was and is not an end which he desired and that if the aforementioned scenario occurred, it occurred independent of him (Shay).

Shay requested that he be hypnotised to assist the investigation in obtaining any useful information he may have but was unable to recall.

Shay was transported back to the Suffolk County Jail, 200 Nashua Street, Boston, Massachusetts at approximately 6:30 PM.

This investigation is continuing.
