9. DETAILS:

REPORT OF INTERVIEW

With Thomas L. Shay, on September 17, 1992, at 2:30PM., at 39 Eastbourne St. Roslindale, Massachusetts, by Special Agents Thomas E. D'Ambrosio and Jeffery S. Kerr, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms.

Mr. Shay states as follows:

Mr. Shay stated that he was willing to talk with the above Special Agents without his attorney present.

Mr Shay stated, when asked, that he had read the newspaper articles relating to his son, Thomas A. Shay and that he was not disturbed by the references to his alleged abuse of his former wife. Mr. Shay said that he was not surprised that his son would make those statements to the press.

Mr. Shay was advised that his son may be released from jail the following day. Mr. Shay stated that he "knows what Tom looks like".

Mr. Shay was asked to repeat his version of finding the device in his driveway. He stated that his recollection of finding the bomb has not changed from what he has said in the past. He stated that he never knew that it was a bomb, but he did suspect that it was "something dangerous". When asked to clarify that statement, Mr. Shay stated that, "I didn't know it was a bomb". He further stated that he had nothing new to offer in the way of information that might be helpful.
