REPORT OF INTERVIEW

With Judy Fredette, on January 21, 1993, at 11:30AM., at 38 Shaw St. Apt. 3, Quincy, Massachusetts, by Special Agents Thomas E. D'Ambrosio and Jeff S. Kerr, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms.

Ms. Fredette states as follows:

Ms. Fredette said that her date of birth is December 11, 1962, her Social Security number is ██████████, she has lived at her current address for approximately three years and the telephone number is 328-8506.

She said that she has known Alfred Trenkler since the time he lived in Hull, Massachusetts. She said that she began working for ARCOM on November 11 or 12, 1991, and was paid five dollars an hour under the table. She said that her hours were flexible but that she generally worked 9:00am to 1:00pm. Her duties were to answer the telephone, take messages and file. She said that she continued to work for ARCOM until January 1992. She stopped working because she was not being paid and is in fact still owed wages. She said that ARCOM did not use timecards to keep track of hours worked by the employees. She said that she was not always aware of Trenkler's or Brown's daily activities.

Ms. Fredette stated that she has seen Al Trenkler smoke marijuana and that he told her that he had a cocaine problem, although she has not seen Trenkler use cocaine. She further stated that since she has left ARCOM she has been visited at her apartment by Al Trenkler approximately five

She further stated that an investigator attempted to interview her, but that she avoided the interview by not returning home.
