- K1 - Pages 1, 3, 5, and 7 of ATF Handwriting Booklet Form 7130.7, dated 6-4-92, containing handprinting and signature exemplars of Thomas A. Shay.
- K2, K3 - Two (2) ATF Handwriting Booklet Forms 7130.7, dated 24 Sept 92, containing handprinting, an signature exemplars of Alfred W. Trenkler.
- K4 - Two (2) sheets of white, line paper, containing handprinting and handwriting exemplars of Alfred W. Trenkler.

RESULTS OF EXAMINATION

The K1 writer, Thomas A. Shay, wrote the questioned writing appearing on the inside portion of the Q3 exhibit.

The K1 writer probably wrote the James Keough signature appearing on the Q2 exhibit, however, the available exemplars are not adequate to render a more definite conclusion.

The K2 through K4 writer, Arthur W. Trenkler, wrote the endorsements appearing on the back of the Q7, Q8, and Q9 exhibits.


The K1 and K2 through K4 writers, most probably did not write any of the remaining questioned writing appearing on the Q1, Q4, Q5, and Q6 exhibits.
