9. DETAILS:

REPORT OF INTERVIEW

With Richard Brown, on April 12, 1993, telephonically, by Special Agent Dennis P. Leahy, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms. Mr. Brown states as follows:

Mr. Brown said that Jimmy Karolides "keeps bugging me" and my grandfather and that he won't stop calling. Mr. Brown asked that I or the prosecutor call Karolides and tell him to stop the telephone calls. Mr. Brown said that he did not want to speak with Karolides as the "guy guilty as sin" referring to Al Trenkler. Mr. Brown was instructed that it was his decision to speak with Mr. Karolides or not to speak with him.

Mr. Brown again telephonically, in a second call, said that he had just spoken to Karolides for about 20 minutes and the Karolides said to him that the government was lying and that Al Trenkler was at ARCOM painting the day of the bombing. Mr. Brown said Karolides was hostile to him and said that Brown would receive a subpoena for his business records if he did not cooperate with Karolides. Mr. Brown said that he does not remember Al Trenkler painting at ARCOMM the day of the bombing. Mr. Brown again requested that ATF or the U. S. Attorney's office contact Karolides to stop bothering his grandfather and he.
