Dear Ms. Urso:

I would sincerely appreciate it if the Court would delete paragraph 11 from the release order and modify paragraph 4b to permit Mr. Trenkler to come to my office, accompanied by a parent, from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. once per week.

Before sending me the final version (Exhibit A) of release conditions which did not contain paragraph 11, Mr. Kelly raised the issue of visitors. However, when I explained it was important for Mr. Trenkler to be able to meet with visitors who could assist in his defense, he dropped his desire to restrict visitors. Accordingly, said deletion is reflected in Exhibit A.

Paragraph 11, which now appears in the release order (Exhibit B) which the Court signed and which I first saw when I received it, while not eliminating "visitors", could significantly limit my client's ability to meet with people who can materially assist me in his defense and who, because of work schedules, might be unable to meet with Mr. Trenkler at my office between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. once per week. I therefore request that an amended order be issued deleting paragraph 11 altogether and amending paragraph 4b as indicated above.

Treating this letter as a motion to amend the release order, it is denied.
