GOVERNMENT'S MOTION FOR A

JURY VIEW OF THE CRIME SCENE

The United States of America hereby moves the Curt to consider arranging for a view of the crime scene -- 39 Eastbourne Street, Roslindale, Massachusetts -- prior to the taking of evidence in this case. In support of this motion, the government states as follows:

- 1. The decision to permit a view is entrusted to the sound discretion of the trial court. <u>United States v. Passos-Paterina</u>, 918 F.2d 979, 986 (1st Cir. 1990).
- 2. A view will provide the jury with an opportunity to observe first-hand:
 - a. The general layout of the neighborhood;
 - b. The appearance, including width, length and slope, of the driveway at 39 Eastbourne Street where the explosion took place;
 - c. The configuration of vehicles and other objects in an around the driveway (very similar to the way they appeared on October 28, 1991);
 - d. The proximity and relation of certain locations, such as witnesses' homes, to the site of the explosion.
 - 3. The crime scene is no more than twenty (20) minutes
